DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO APPLY:

- Proof of current 30-day gross income from all household members. If you need proof of SSA or SSI benefits go to www.socialsecurity.gov/myaccount for an instant letter.
- Copy of most recent heat and electric bills if you pay for your home energy directly.
- Verbally provide Social Security numbers of all household members (hard-copy of Social Security cards are not required at this time).
- Applicants that have their utilities included in the rent must provide proof of rental agreement stating monthly rental amount, that utilities are included, and landlord contact information. (Rent costs must be greater than 30% of current household 30-day gross income).
