A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE DESTRUCTION OF VERBATIM RECORDS OF CLOSED SESSION MEETINGS

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Open Meetings Act (the "Act"), 5 ILCS 120/1 et seq., the Supervisor and Board of Trustees (collectively, the "Board") of Hanover Township (the "Township") must keep written minutes of all their meetings, whether open or closed; and

WHEREAS, the Act requires the Board to keep a verbatim record of all their closed meetings in the form of an audio or video recording, and the Township Clerk has kept such records as required by the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Act provides that the verbatim record of a closed meeting may be destroyed no less than eighteen (18) months after the completion of the meeting recorded, but only after: (1) the Board approves the destruction of a particular recording; and (2) the Board approves minutes of the closed meeting that meet the requirements of the Act; and

WHEREAS, no less than eighteen (18) months have passed after the completion of the closed session meetings identified in the schedule of closed session meetings attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Board has approved minutes of the closed session meetings identified in the schedule of closed session meetings attached hereto as Exhibit A that meet the requirements of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the verbatim records of the closed session meetings identified in the schedule of closed session meetings attached hereto as Exhibit A are authorized for destruction in accordance with the Act; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Supervisor and Board of Trustees of Hanover Township, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: INCORPORATION OF RECITALS. The foregoing recitals and all exhibits referenced therein are hereby incorporated into the body of this Resolution as though fully set forth herein.

APPROVAL. The destruction of the verbatim records of the SECTION TWO: closed session meetings identified in the schedule of closed session meetings attached hereto as Exhibit A is hereby approved, and the Township Clerk is authorized and directed to destroy the verbatim records of the closed session meetings identified in the schedule of closed session meetings attached hereto as Exhibit A within seven (7) days following the approval of this Resolution.

SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph, or provision of SECTION THREE: this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

REPEALER. All prior Ordinances and Resolutions in conflict SECTION FOUR: or inconsistent herewith are hereby expressly repealed only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall be in full force SECTION FIVE: and effect upon its passage and approval.
