Residents can drive through the Township’s Emergency Services Station at 300 S. IL Route 59 in Bartlett to have their vehicles unloaded. Collected items will be distributed to local families as part of the Township’s holiday programs.

“Compared to last year, we are currently experiencing a 17% increase in the number of families who have registered for our annual toy drive and sponsor-a-family programs,” said Brian McGuire, Hanover Township Supervisor. “Whether it’s one game or puzzle, a basketball or complete set of action figures, donations of all sizes are truly appreciated.”
