

Hanover Township  
Tax Levy Ordinance  
Ordinance 122121

An Ordinance levying taxes for all corporate purposes for HANOVER TOWNSHIP , COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2021 and ending March 31, 2022.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Hanover Township, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the sum of SEVEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY FIVE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETY NINE DOLLARS (\$7,555,999) is hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized for the current year, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

**SECTION 3:** That the Town Clerk shall make and file with the Clerk of said County of Cook, before the time required by law, a duly certified copy of this Ordinance, and it is hereby directed that the aforesaid sum of \$7,555,999.00 be raised by taxation in the manner provided by law.

**SECTION 4:** That if any section, subdivision or sentence of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or found to be unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption as provided by law.

**SECTION 6:** That all prior ordinances and resolutions in conflict or inconsistent herewith are expressly repealed only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.


