Hanover Township Job Fair set for March 27

Hanover Township, Representative Fred Crespo, and Cook County Commissioner Kevin B. Morrison are co-sponsoring the 13th Annual Community Job Fair on Wednesday, March 27. The event is open exclusively to veterans from 11AM to 11:30AM and open to the public from 11:30AM to 2PM at the Hanover Township Senior Center, 240 S. IL Route 59 in Bartlett. Job seekers are asked to bring copies of their resumes to the event.

"We frequently hear from residents who are underemployed or simply seeking new opportunities in new fields," said Hanover Township Supervisor Brian P. McGuire. "Our Job Fair is a great opportunity for those 18 and over to apply for a variety of positions and in most cases, be interviewed on the spot."

Over 70 employers will be onsite in the fields of healthcare, manufacturing, sales, administrative, transportation, and more.

"One of the best ways to stimulate our economy is to help people who are unemployed or underemployed find appropriate employment," said State Representative Fred Crespo. "This job fair has been a great way to connect candidates and companies in a meaningful and hopefully fruitful way."

According to the Illinois Department of Employment Security, the unemployment rate for Cook County is 4%.

Staff from the North Suburban Cook County American Job Center will also offer a workshop at 12PM for event attendees on how to access free employment-seeking resources. Registration is not required.

Legal Aid Chicago will also be presenting at 1PM on the free services offered to residents who have limited income or special legals needs in the areas of family and safety, housing, money and debt, work and employment rights, health disability and basic needs, and immigration.
