- B. <u>Purpose of Newsletter Advertising</u>: The sole purpose of the Township in allowing advertising inits newsletters is to generate reven ue to offset the cost of such newsletters to the Township. These guidelines for advertising are intended to establish uniform, viewpoint-neutral standards for newsletter advertising ing.
- C. OtherAdvertising: Hanover Township will allow limited advertising on Hanover Township signs, banners, and posters that promote Township events and programs. Townshipsigns, banners, and posters allow the Town shiptonotify Township residents of upcoming Township events and programs. The solepu advertising on its signs, banners, and posters, is togenerate revenue to support Township events and programs. The seguidelines for advertising are intended to establish uniform, viewpoint-neutral standards for advertising on Town shipsigns, banners, and posters.
- D. <u>Non-PublicForum</u>: ItisthepolicyoftheTownshipthatitsnewslet ters, signs, banners, and posters are not public forums for political dis course or expressive activity. The newsletters, signs, banners, and posters are not in tended to provide a forum for all types of advertisements, but only the limited advertisements.
- E. Purpose of the Hanover Township Advertising Guid elines: The purpose of these guidelinesistomaintainaprofessionaladvertisin genvironmentthatadvancesthegoalof generating revenue to the Township to offset the co st of Township Newsletters, and to generate revenue to support Township events and pro grams, and is consistent with the purpose of providing information about Township pro grams and services to Township residents. These guidelines advance this objective by prohibiting advertisements that create controversy, interfere with and divertres ou rces from Township operations, would be harmful to the public generally, or would be vie wed as offensive by Township residents. Such advertisements can detract from the goal of generating revenue, and are ation about Township programs and not consistent with the purpose of providing inform services to Township residents. The Township furthe r seeks to maintain a position of neutrality on political, social, religious, or othe r public issues that are the subject of publicdebateandconcern.
- F. <u>Excluded Advertising</u>: Advertisements that fall into one of the followin gcategories may not be placed in the Township's new sletters or on Township signs, banners, or posters:

- 1. False, deceptive, or misleading. Commerciala dvertising offering premiums or gifts must not misstate their value.
- 2. Commercialadvertisingthatproposestransacti unlawfuldiscriminationorwouldbeillegalfora permitted. onswhichwouldconstitute nyotherreasonisnot
- 3. Advertisingforfirearms,ammunition,stungun s,ortasers,oranyarticle ofwhichthepossessionofisprohibitedby720I LCS5/24-1(a),andas suchlawmaybeamended,modified,orsupplemente d.
- 4. Advertisingthatdepictsweaponsordevicesin anactoractsofviolence onapersonorthatappearstobeaimedorpointe observedinamenacingmanner.
- 5. Advertisingthatcontainsobsceneoroffensive content.Theterm "obscene"shallhavethesamemeaninghereinasi andassuchlawmaybeamended,modified,orsupp lemented.
- 6. Advertisingthatdepictsorpromotesthesale of alcohol, to bacco, or any illegal productors ervice.
- 7. Advertisingthatsupportsoropposestheelect candidateorgroupofcandidatesforanypublico federal, state, judicial, orlocalgovernmentoff ices.
- 8. Advertisingthatispoliticalinnatureorcon tainpoliticalmessages, includingadvertisinginvolvingpoliticalorjudi advertisementsinvolvinganissuethatispolitic opposesorsupportsthepassageofanylaw,ordin orthatopposesorsupportsanypublicpolicyiss ue.
- 8. AdvertisingthatcontainsTownshipgraphicsor representationswithout theexpresswrittenconsentoftheTownship.
- 9. Advertisingdepictingnudity,sexualconduct, orsexualexcitement. The terms "nudity," "sexualconduct," and "sexualexcitement" shall have the same meaning shere in a sin 720 ILCS 5/11-21(a) a mean ded, modified, or supplemented.
- 10. Advertisingthatportraysgraphicviolence,s uchasthroughthedepiction ofhumanoranimalbodies,bodyparts,orfetuses instatesofmutilation, dismemberment,disfigurement,ordecomposition.

- J. <u>Severability:</u> If any section, paragraph or provision of these G uidelines shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect a ny of the remaining provisions of these Guidelines.
