When to File an Appeal

In Cook County, a general reassessment is conducted every three years to comply with Illinois law. With 1.8 million parcels in Cook County, it is understandable that a small percentage of individual properties may not be accurately assessed. If you believe your proposed assessed valuation to be too high, or the description of your property to be inaccurate, you may correct this by filing an appeal with the Assessor's Office at the designated time for Hanover Township.
